Many of the materials used in the manufacture of furniture are natural, therefore, any natural markings are going to be unique to that item of furniture

## Leather furniture

Leather is a natural product. It breathes, is warm and has individual characteristics, which make it unique.

Leather will always display traces of its origin such as scars, creases, insect bits and differences in grain and colour.

All leather is flexible and with time will stretch and mould itself to shape.  
This is most often seen on the seat and back cushions.
